

Dear Families/Guardians of Camp Sertoma Campers,

Sunscreen is now considered a drug and must be checked and logged by all summer camps in New York State. The following three rules must be met:

- 1). The sunscreen will only be used to prevent overexposure to the sun.
- 2). Only FDA-approved sunscreen for over-the-counter-use will be permitted.
- 3). Written permission from the camper's parent or guardian will be provided to and kept on file at Camp Sertoma allowing the camper to carry and self-administer the sunscreen.

If you will be providing your child with sunscreen for at-camp use, please read and sign the top section of the form below. If you feel your child is unable to apply the sunscreen him- or herself but you would like your child to receive the benefits of sunscreen use, please sign the lower section of the form, allowing camp staff to assist in the application of your child's sunscreen.
